

Santa Claus Parade Information

We are so excited for Santa Claus Parade Saturday December 1st. Here is some important information that you will need to know.

What to wear: Dancers are required to wear black or dark bottoms and tops/jackets (or studiomwear jackets and shirts). Accessories (mini cape, white gloves, toque and small mask) will be provided the day of the parade. Please dress warm, it is a long walk outside. Hair should be in a pony tail, if possible, for parade.

Safety is our first concern so please be prompt with the drop off and particularly **pick up times**.

FLOAT # 40 out of 98 floats

DROP OFF TIME: 4:15 to 4:30pm

DROP OFF LOCATION: At the south west corner of London St. and George St. We suggest carpooling for drop off and pick up. If you do carpool, please email me at dance@afrostdance.com so I know who is signing students in and out.

PICK UP TIME: by 6:15pm. Please do not be late, **do not wait for the parade to end to pick up your children**. Please send your cell phone number with your child (if they are a Junior or Intermediate) in case we need to call you at any point.

PICK UP LOCATION: The Morrow Building side door facing Roger Neilson street. It is the small flea market building on the left. We will stay there for parent pick up, so please find us, don't make your child find you.

Important Reminders: Please make sure to have a hearty lunch/early dinner as we are dancing the parade route, we will be taking breaks from dancing and walking, but it's still a fairly long route. There are no washrooms along the route so it is imperative that students use the washroom before they line up.

The parade starts at 4:45pm and usually takes 45-60 minutes to walk down George St. The Parade ends at Lansdowne Street. We will go straight across Lansdowne Street, and head to the Morrow Building for pick up.

PLEASE BE PROMPT TO PICK UP.
